GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (FIREWORK DISPLAY) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT) ORDER 2018

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 62(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers being satisfied that traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedules hereto should be prohibited or restricted to facilitate the holding of the Fireworks Display and to enable members of the public to watch this event and being satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for the event to be held otherwise than on a road and having had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order, makes the above-named Order to be observed by vehicles on the following roads:-

- This Order may be cited as the GLASGOW CITY COUNCIL (FIREWORK DISPLAY) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)
 ORDER 2018 and shall come into operation on the Fourth Day of November, Two Thousand and Eighteen and shall have effect for
 two days only.
- 2. Save as provided by Article 3 to this Order, no person shall:-
 - (a) drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on those roads specified in Schedule 1 hereto between the times specified in Schedule 1 hereto.
 - (b) cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load or unload from any vehicle on the areas of roads specified in Schedule 2 hereto between the times specified in Schedule 2 hereto.
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to :-
 - (a) An emergency services vehicle.
 - (b) A vehicle which is there in connection with the Firework Display and has been given permission to be there by the Glasgow City Council.
- 4. The lengths of bus lane on the road specified in Schedule 3 hereto may be used by all classes of traffic between the times specified in the said Schedule.
- 5. The Order will apply to the specified roads at the times specified in the Schedules hereto as indicated by appropriate traffic signs or under the instruction of a police officer in uniform and the effect will be to impose temporary prohibitions and restrictions on use.
